

PARKING INFORMATION

The Ackland Art Museum does not have a dedicated visitor parking lot. Instead, parking can be found at many nearby town lots.

BUSES

Bus drivers should be prepared to drop off their group in front of the Ackland and then park the bus off-site. Parking for school or coach buses is available in the **University Place Mall parking lot**.

- Turn right on E. Franklin Street and travel 1.8 miles to Estes Drive.
- Turn right onto S. Estes Drive and go 0.4 miles.
- University Place will be on the left.

*If the driver is one of your chaperones, you must arrange for someone to transport them to the Museum as it is a forty-minute walk from University Place Mall. The Chapel Hill Transit (free) [G Route Bus](#) is also available on a limited schedule from University Place Mall (#6) to the Ackland Art Museum (#3).

General instructions for the bus driver:

- ✓ Going north on S. Columbia Street (toward Franklin Street), stop in the far-right lane in front of the Ackland Art Museum and put on your flashers.
- ✓ As you unload, make sure that at least one adult gets off the bus with every 12-15 students.
- ✓ After unloading, park the bus/van at University Place Mall.
- ✓ Return to the Ackland (please allow 10 minutes of travel time) and stop again in front of the Museum for the children to load back on the bus.

[Alternative bus parking](#) available in the following UNC locations (see maps on page 4):

- The corner of Boundary Street and Battle Lane behind the Forest Theater. One space is available until 12:00 noon on a first-come, first served basis. (not sure if time has been extended to 2:00p)
- The travel lane in front of the Dean E. Smith Center may be used unless area is reserved unless area is reserved for Smith Center or Kenan Stadium event. Please do not block the Chapel Hill Transit bus stop.

FIFTEEN-PASSANGER VANS

If you are driving a fifteen-passenger van, you may park it in the open public lot on the corner of Rosemary and Columbia street: 100 E Rosemary Street, Chapel Hill, NC (see map on page 5 – lot #15).

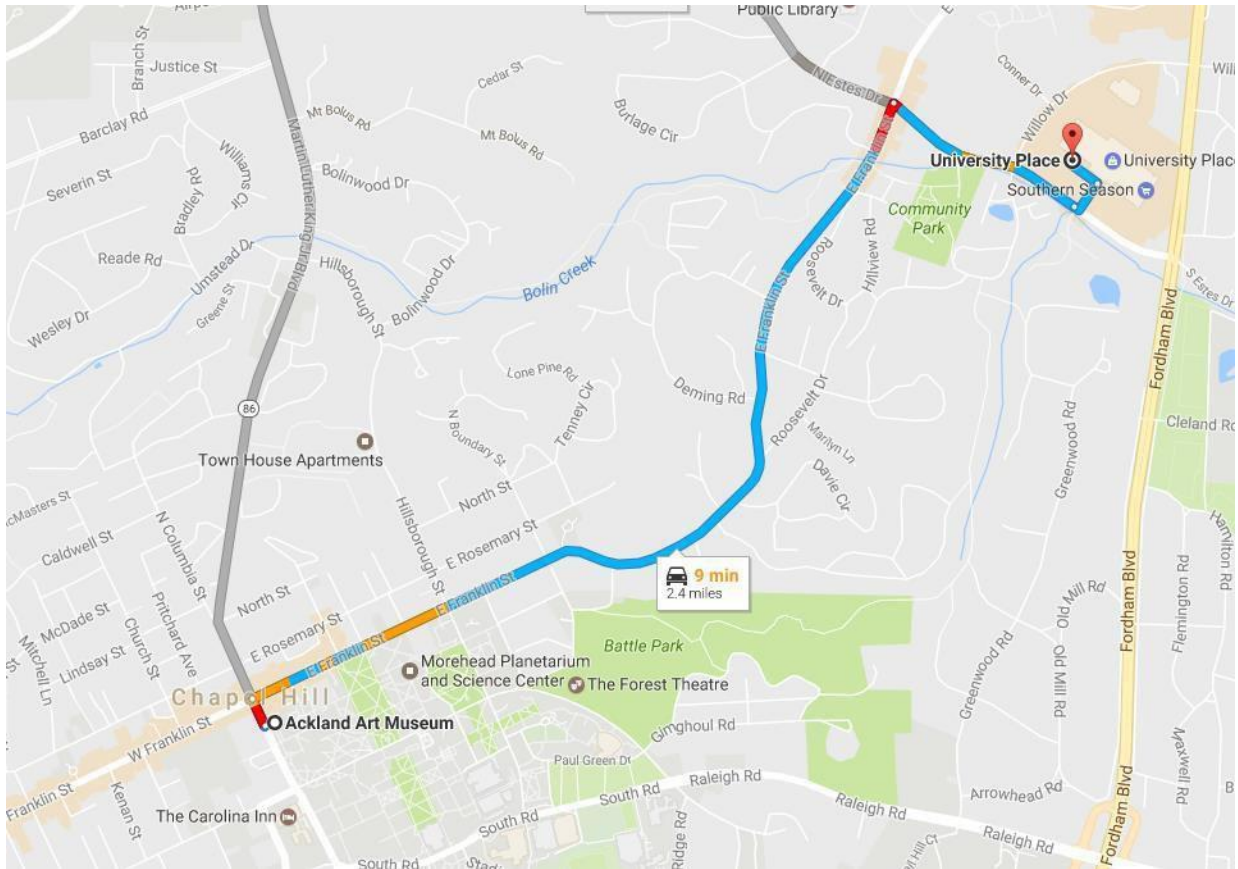
CARS

If you are in a private car, you may use any of the Town of Chapel Hill lots (see page 5). The costs for these lots range from \$1.00 – \$1.50 an hour. All charges can be paid by cash or card. As parking regulations often change, please feel free to check the Town of Chapel Hill website before your visit: www.parkonthehill.com.

The Ackland Art Museum is on South Columbia Street near the corner of Franklin Street. The closest lots to the Museum are (see yellow highlighted numbers on page 5):

Bus Parking – offsite at University Place Mall



Bus drivers should be prepared to drop off their group in front of the Ackland and then park the bus off-site. Parking for school or coach buses is available in the University Place parking lot.

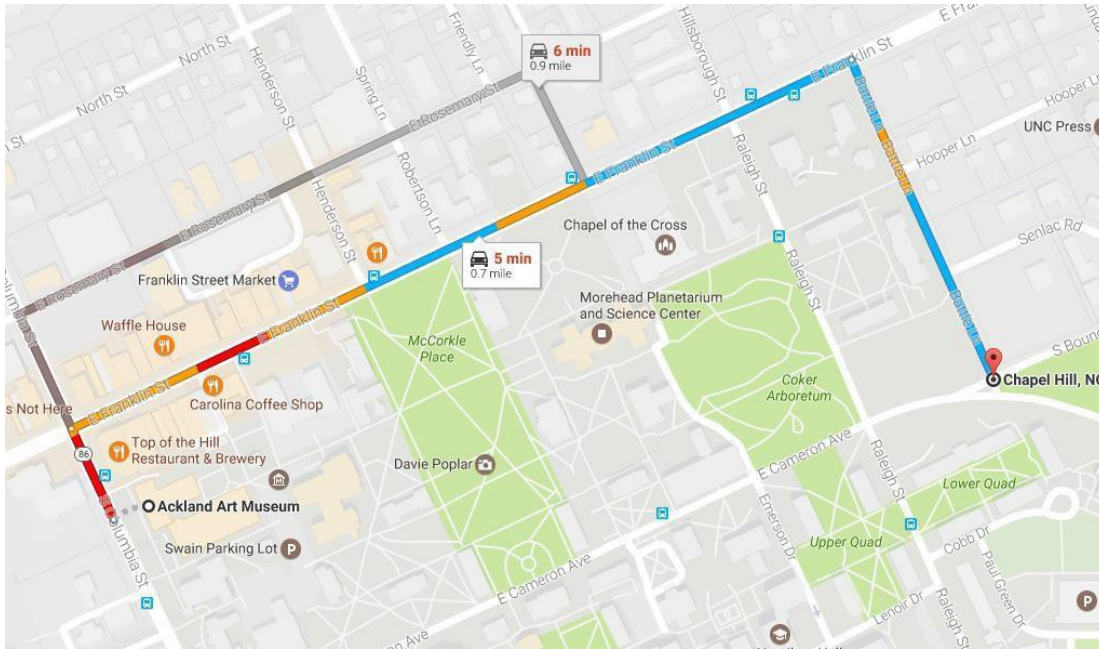
- Turn right on E. Franklin Street and travel 1.8 miles to Estes Drive.

Alternative Bus Parking on UNC-Chapel Hill campus

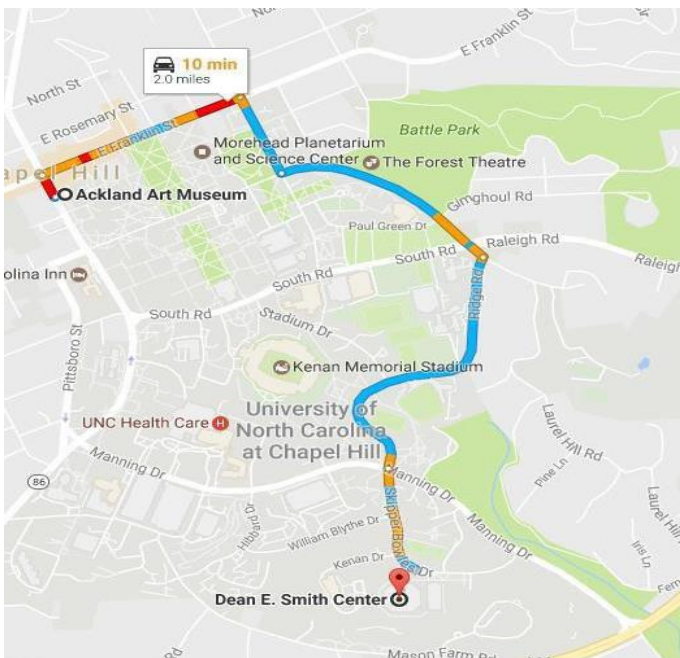
Boundary Street and Battle Lane:

Dean E. Smith Center Parking:



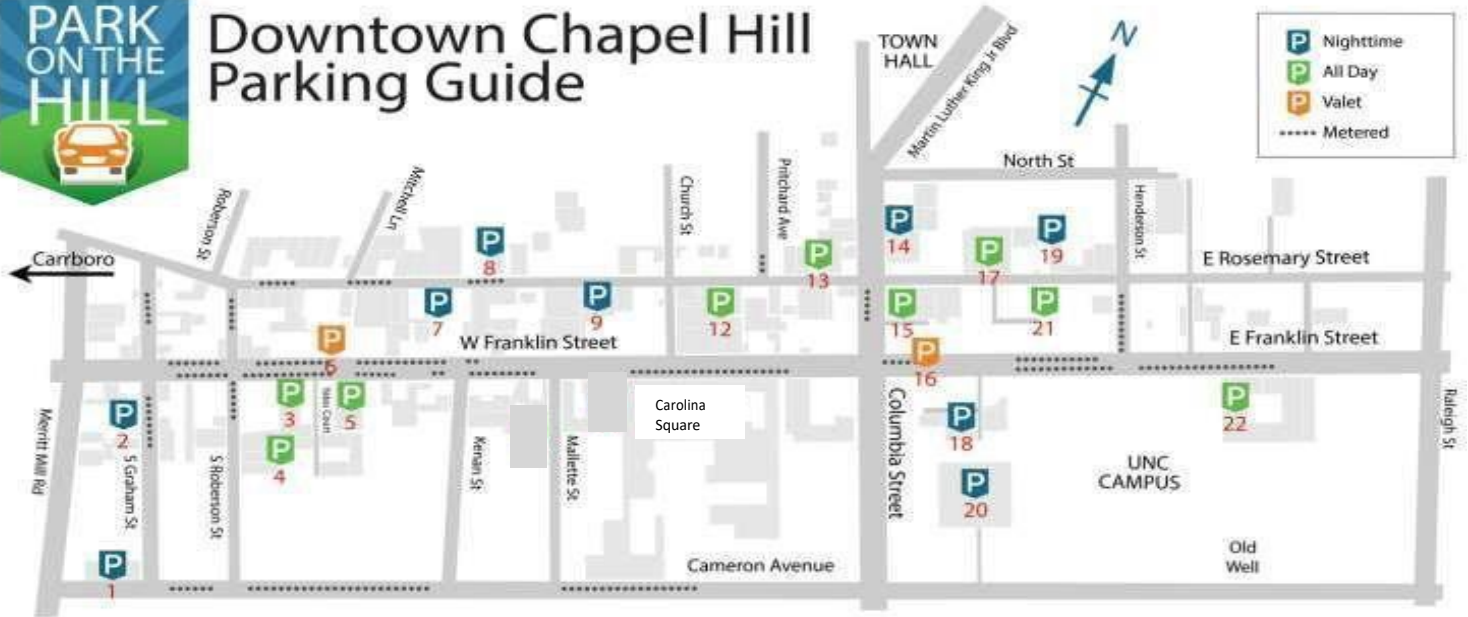

- Turn right onto Ridge Rd
- Continue onto Skipper Bowles Dr.
